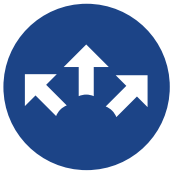

building trust within communities through direct interaction and dialogue



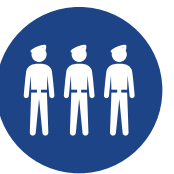
Public order
