PRIORITIES



Civilian Security Sector Reform

Supporting the roll-out of comprehensive and irreversible reforms for in the civilian security sector as part of Ukraine's EU accession, process, including for the implementation of the Overarching Strategic Plan for Reform of the Entire Law Enforcement Sector (OAS).



Integrated Border Management

Supporting the implementation of an Integrated State Border Management Strategy that brings Ukraine in line with EU standards and best practices, including Schengen requirements and EU Customs Union standards.



Reintegration of Veterans

Supporting the rehabilitation and reintegration of veterans into civilian life, in close coordination with other EU partners, EU Member States, and other international actors.



International Crimes

Supporting Ukrainian partners in the investigation and prosecution of international crimes, including war crimes.



Liberated and Adjacent Territories

Supporting Ukrainian law enforcement agencies' (LEA) role in stabilisation in war-affected areas by enhancing LEA capabilities and resilience, and by promoting social cohesion and reintegration through community policing and community safety dialogue.



Organised Crime

Supporting the strengthening of law enforcement capabilities to counter the proliferation of Small Arms and Light Weapons (SALW), smuggling in all its forms, financial crimes, cybercrimes, and the links between organised crime and hybrid threats.



Hybrid Threats

Supporting the development of strategies, policies, and capacities to counter hybrid threats, including critical infrastructure protection, cybersecurity, FIMI, and prevention of the recruitment of vulnerable groups for subversive actions.

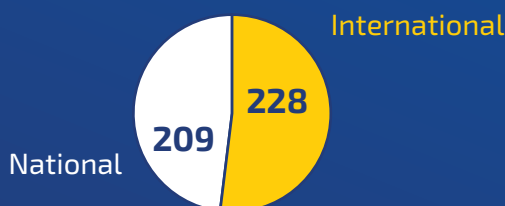

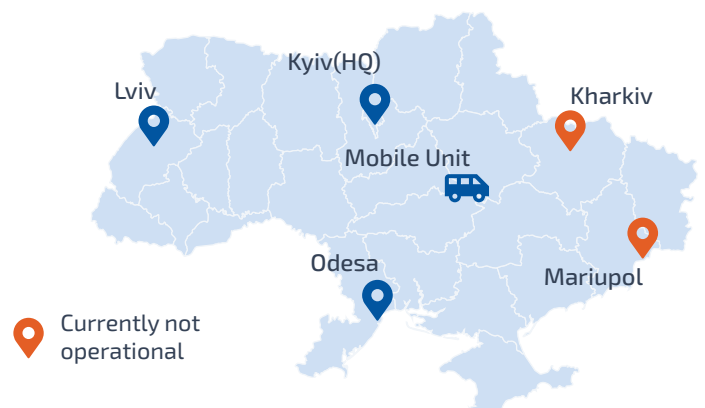
